Subject: Ash Class Assembly - Thursday 4th June

We wanted to let you know that the Ash Class assembly will take place the week after the half term on Thursday 4th June. All parents and carers are welcome to attend. The assembly will start at 10.10am but it is best to arrive earlier to find your seat.

We will be using our topic theme of the Ancient Greeks and would like the children to have a simple costume that will make them look the part. The aim is for them all to be wearing a white, Grecian-style tunic. This could be made from folding and pinning a tablecloth or old sheet (knee length for the boys, ankle length for the girls). Please don't cut up the best sheets, as the aim is to keep it simple, cheap and easy! The costume can then be completed with a belt or chord to secure it at the waist. If your child would like to get creative with the kitchen foil, they may like to create some jewellery to go with their costume.

there are some suggestions for how to create an easy tunic. I would request please that, to avoid doing too much complex dressing on the performance day, as much of the necessary pinning as possible is done before your child brings in their costume.

Could children please bring in their prepared costume in a labelled bag by Tuesday 2nd June. Please do consider that, as one white sheet or tablecloth looks a lot like another, it might be useful to discreetly attach a name label onto your child's costume.
