The role of our Governing Body

I wanted to share more information with you regarding our Governing Body. It is our role to ensure that we strive for academic excellence and we nourish our children's spiritual, emotional and educational development. We are responsible for:

- 1. Ensuring clarity of vision, ethos and strategic direction.
- 2. Holding school leaders to account for the educational performance of the organisation and its pupils, and the performance management of staff.
- 3. Overseeing the financial performance of the organisation making sure its money is well spent.

Our priorities for this year include:

- 1. Improving school admission levels by raising awareness of our school.
- 2. Monitoring the implementation and impact of progression of knowledge and skills in all areas of the curriculum for all learners.
- 3. Increased engagement with our community to improve education and pupil experience.
- 4. A review of our premises to identify areas for improvement together with a focus on road safety outside our school.

School Buildings Fund

As a voluntary aided school whose buildings are owned by the Catholic Archdiocese of Birmingham, the school always has to pay at least 10% of the costs of any building work. Once we have found the 10%, the rest will usually be matched by 90% from Diocesan capital funds or Local Authority grants. We often cannot plan for urgent work so we have a fundraising building fund to help raise this 10%.
