

Maths:**Ratio and proportion:**

This term the children will solve problems involving the relative sizes of two quantities where missing values can be found by using the integer multiplication and division facts. They will also use percentages for comparison.

Algebra

We will use simple formulae to generate and describe linear number sequences. They will express missing number problems algebraically and find pairs of numbers that satisfy an equation with two unknowns

Decimals

The children will calculate decimal fraction equivalents for a simple fraction and multiply and divide numbers by 10, 100 and 1000. They will multiply decimal numbers and solve problems that require rounding. They also will recall equivalences between simple fractions, decimals and percentages.

Statistics

The children will interpret and construct pie charts and line graphs to solve problems. They will also calculate and interpret the mean as an average.

RE:**Christmas:**

This term the children will explore the story of the birth of Christ and learn about the different Gospel perspectives. They will also explore different images of Christ.

Baptism and Confirmation Celebrations

The children will learn about sacraments of baptism and confirmation. They will explore signs and symbols of these sacraments and the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Lent and Holy Week:

The children will be given the opportunities to develop their knowledge and understanding of prayer, fasting and almsgiving as important Lenten activities. We will also be learning about the events that took place in the Garden of Gethsemane through to the death of Jesus on the cross

Music:

This term, the pupils will play and perform in solo and ensemble contexts, using their voices and playing musical instruments with increasing accuracy, fluency, control and expression



Topic Web

English

Class books: Secrets of a Sun King by Emma Carroll and The Story of Tutankhamun by Patricia Cleveland-Peck

This term, the types of writing that the pupils will be focusing on are: narratives, letters, non-chronological reports and instructions.

**Grammar and punctuation:**

This term the children will focus on using expanded noun phrases to convey complicated information concisely, ensuring the consistent and correct use of tense throughout a piece of writing and using passive verbs to affect the presentation of information in a sentence

Art/ DT

This term, in art the children will be doing a unit about 'Brave Colour'. They will take inspiration from artists who use colour, light and form to create immersive installations. They are enabled to imagine "what if...?" and encouraged to share their vision or imagining with others through mock-up artworks and models. In DT, the children will be exploring and constructing frame structures. They will also be investigating the strengths and weaknesses of their structures.

Topic:

This term the children will be learning about the achievements of the earliest civilisations. They will learn about where and when the first civilisations appeared and explore the daily life and culture of Ancient Egypt. We will also be exploring about their beliefs about the afterlife and how they prepared for it. Additionally, we will be comparing Ancient Egypt with other civilisations in the same time period.

This learning will be supported and linked to our class books that we are studying in our English unit.

Science:**Light:**

This term will start with us exploring light as part of our physics unit. We will be learning about how we see (eyesight and refraction), light and straight lines, shadow formation and then will be conducting a shadow experiment. We also will be learning about light pollution towards the end of this unit.

The Circulatory System:

After light, the children will be learning about the circulatory system in the body. We will be learning about blood, the heart, blood flow and oxygenated and deoxygenated blood.

Diet, Drugs and Lifestyle:

Towards the end of Spring term we will be learning about our diet, drugs and lifestyle and how these can impact our health. We will be planning and carrying out a heart rate experiment.

Language

This term, the pupils will learn Italian words and phrases

PE:**Gymnastics:**

This term the children will be learning and exploring a range of different gymnastic skills. These PE lessons will focus on how we move our bodies, ranges of different movements and refining skills such as balancing, agility and flexibility.

Circuit training and leadership skills:

We will be continuing to refine our leadership and problem solving skills in sport. We will be focusing on how we conduct ourselves in team sports, encouraging others and becoming motivational team leaders. The children will get the opportunity to lead different PE lessons and independently run activities for their peers.

PE will be on Wednesday and Thursday

PSHE:

We will be discussing emotional changes and the changes in our bodies.

Computing:

This term, the pupils will be learning about programming and coding variables in games. We also will be learning about creating and navigating spreadsheets
